NIRMALA SITHARAMAN

Hon'ble Minister of Finance & Corporate

Affairs, India

Smt. Nirmala Sitharaman was born on 18th August, 1959 in Madurai, Tamil Nadu to Smt. K. Savitri and Shri K. Sitharaman. She completed her bachelors from Seethalakshmi Ramaswami College in Trichirapalli and headed to the Jawahar Lal Nehru University to pursue her masters in Economics. After submitting her doctoral thesis on Indo-European Textile Trade, she moved to UK and worked as the Senior Manager (Research & Analysis) in Price Waterhouse, London. During her stay in London, she also worked briefly for BBC World Services.

Post her return to India, she was keen on working towards institutionalizing Policy Analysis in India and therefore established Centre for Public Policy Studies in Hyderabad in 1992. In 1997, She established Pranava, a school in Hyderabad that won the British Council's International School Award, 2007-2010 for its unconventional approach to education that prioritized giving shape to a child's inherent talent over the conventional learn and rote system.

From 2003-2005, she served as a member of the National Commission for Women and in 2008, she was invited to become a member of the BJP's National Executive and since then she has been actively involved in drafting almost all of party's Economic and Political Resolutions. In 2010, Smt. Sitharaman was appointed as the National Spokesperson of the BJP and was widely respected for her well researched and graceful articulation of the party's stand.

During the Gujarat Assembly Elections in 2012, Smt. Sitharaman worked

directly under the leadership of Shri Narendra Modi wherein she was given the responsibility of organizing BJP's Media Campaign for the elections. After the historic victory of BJP in 2014 General Elections, she was inducted into the Council of Ministers and she held the charge of Minister of State (Independent charge) for Commerce & Industry.

In May 2016, she was one of the 12 candidates nominated by the BJP to contest the Rajya Sabha elections on 11 June 2016. She successfully contested her seat from Karnataka. On 3 September 2017, she became the first full-time woman Defence Minister of India. After landslide victory of BJP in the General Elections of 2019, Smt. Sitharaman was given the responsibility of the Finance and Corporate Affairs Minister of India.



S. JAISHANKAR Hon'ble Minister of External Affairs, India

Dr. S. Jaishankar is India's External Affairs Minister since May 30th, 2019. He is a Member of the Upper House (Rajya Sabha) of India's Parliament from the state of Gujarat.

He was Foreign Secretary from 2015-18, Ambassador to United States (2013-15), China (2009-2013) and Czech Republic (2000-2004). He was High Commissioner to Singapore (2007-2009).

He has also served in other diplomatic assignments in Embassies in Moscow, Colombo, Budapest and Tokyo, as well in the Ministry of External Affairs and the President's Secretariat. He was also President – Global Corporate Affairs at Tata Sons Private Limited from May 2018.

Dr S. Jaishankar is a graduate of St. Stephen's College at the University of Delhi. He has a Masters in Political Science and an M. Phil and Ph.D in International Relations from Jawaharlal Nehru University, Delhi.

He is a recipient of the Padma Shri award in 2019 and has written a widely acclaimed best-selling book: The India Way: Strategies for an Uncertain World, which was published in 2020.



PIYUSH GOYAL

Hon'ble Minister of Commerce and Industry,
Textiles, Consumer Affairs, Food and Public
Distribution, India

Piyush Goyal (59) is the Minister of Commerce & Industry (2019-present), Consumer Affairs, Food & Public Distribution (2020-present), Textiles (2021-present) and Leader of the Rajya Sabha (2021-present). He has also held the portfolio of Minister of Railways, Finance, Corporate Affairs, Coal, Power, New & Renewable Energy and Mines previously.

In his tenure as Minister of Commerce & Industry, India achieved its highest ever exports of about \$675 billion in 2021-22. He led the signing of a Free Trade Agreement (FTA) with UAE, the fastest ever negotiated FTA globally and the India-Australia Economic Cooperation and Trade Agreement (ECTA), India's 1st agreement with a developed country after a decade. He oversaw the launch of Production Linked Incentive (PLI) Schemes to bring manufacturing at the center stage and emphasize its significance in driving growth and creating jobs.

As Minister of Consumer Affairs, Food & Public distribution, he led the implementation of the world's largest food security programme, Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Anna Yojana (PMGKAY) by distribution of free foodgrains to nearly 80 crore people over 2 years, providing support to the poor, vulnerable, weaker sections of society, who were affected the most during the COVID-19 pandemic. As Minister of Railways, India achieved the best ever safety record of zero passenger deaths in rail accidents.

During his 35 year long political career, Mr Goyal has held several important positions at different levels in the world's largest political party, the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) and is in its National Executive. He has been the National Treasurer of the Party.

Mr Goyal has had a brilliant academic record – all India second rank holder Chartered Accountant and second rank holder in Law in Mumbai University. He was a well-known investment banker and has advised top corporations on management strategy and growth.

He is married to Seema, an active social worker, and has two children – Dhruv and Radhika, who have both graduated from Harvard University, USA.



DHARMENDRA PRADHANHon'ble Minister of Education, Skill
Development and Entrepreneurship, India

Dharmendra Pradhan is the Cabinet Minister for Education and Skill Development and Entrepreneurship in the Government of India. As a Member of Parliament, Shri Pradhan represents Madhya Pradesh in the Rajya Sabha and was earlier a member of the 14th Lok Sabha. Born June 26th, 1969, he hails from the city of Talcher in Odisha

As the Minister of Petroleum & Natural Gas of India, Shri Pradhan is attributed with several progressive reforms & initiatives, including consumer initiatives like PAHAL, which is the world's largest Direct Benefit Transfer Scheme and the #GiveltUp campaign that was ardently supported by the Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi. The campaign urged affluent citizens to surrender their LPG subsidy for the needy - this received a successful response from about 10 million consumers. In an attempt to empower rural India with the clean fuel of Liquefied Petroleum Gas (LPG), the Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana was launched by the Ministry of Petroleum & Natural Gas under which over 80 million LPG connections have been provided to women from Below Poverty Line (BPL) families.

Minister Pradhan took some key decisions in the hydrocarbon sector. Supported by the Union Cabinet, he brought in a new Hydrocarbon Exploration & Licensing Policy (HELP), which through its uniform licensing for explorations and production of all forms of hydrocarbon, open acreage policy and marketing and pricing freedom also enhances domestic oil & gas production with substantial

investment in the sector and also generating sizable employment.

Minister Pradhan has also undertaken several reforms and initiatives to aid the energy transition efforts of the country, which includes promoting gas as a bridge fuel, ethanol, CBG & biodiesel, implementing the SATAT scheme, promoting hydrogen-blended CNG buses plying the city of Delhi for use as a transport fuel as well as an industrial to refineries, promoting liquefied natural gas (LNG) stations for long-haul trucks among other initiatives.

In his previous tenure as the Minister for Skill Development & Entrepreneurship (2017-19), Shri Pradhan also launched many key initiatives focussing on skilling, reskilling and upskilling the manpower of India and emphasized on bridging the skills gap for the Indian youth.

A post-graduate from Utkal University, Bhubaneswar, in Anthropology, he has actively pursued several issues concerning the youth, such as unemployment, the lack of skill-based education, rehabilitation and resettlement of farmers, and has played a major role in mobilising the youth in Odisha.

Shri Pradhan started as an Akhil Bhartiya Vidyarthi Parishad (ABVP) activist in 1983, and has served in ABVP as Secretary. He has also worked as an election in-charge in Bihar and as an in-charge of party affairs in Karnataka, Uttarakhand, Jharkhand and Odisha

Following his contribution to society and the party, Pradhan was awarded the 'Best Legislator Award', the Utkalmani Gopabandhu Pratibha Samman, 2002-03 and the Odisha Citizens' Award in 2013.

He is married to Mridula Pradhan and has two children, Nishant & Namaisha.



H.E. TIPU MUNSHI
Commerce Minister,
Government of Bangladesh

Veteran Freedom Fighter Mr. Tipu Munshi, MP, Minister for Commerce Ministry was born on 25 August,1950 in Gopalganj in a reputed muslim family. Afterwards he moved to Pirgacha Upazila of Rangpur district with his family and has been living there. His father Ramjan Ali Munshi was also a Freedom Fighter and his mother was Ratnamoyi Munshi. His wife name is Irin Malobika Munshi.

Mr. Tipu Munshi did his graduation from University of Dhaka. He played pivotal role in the mass uprising of 1969. He has been active in politics for the last 52 years. He was a reputed Bangladesh Student League (Bangladesh Chatra League) leader of Titumir College in 1970. He played leading role in changing the name of Government Jinna College to present Shahid Titumir College. After the independence of Bangladesh he served as chairman of South Tejgaon Chatra League in 1973. He actively participated in Bangladesh Awami League politics along with his business since 1976.

He was elected chairman of Gulshan Thana Awami League in 1992 and he successfully served there for 22 years ceaselessly. In addition to that he also sincerely served as vice-president of Rangpur District Awami League. He took part in our great liberation war with his father, Ramjan Ali Munshi, at the age of 21 years. It is a rear history of our Liberation War that father and son fought directly for the liberation of the mother land.

Mr. Tipu Munshi, as a candidate of Bangladesh Awami League, was elected Member of Parliament of Rangpur-4 constituency on 29 December, 2008 in the 9th parliamentary election for the first time. He was a member of Parliamentary Standing Committee on Ministry of Commerce and Ministry of Jute and Textile in the 9th parliament. He was elected a member of Bangladesh Awami League central executive committee. Tipu Munshi, as a candidate of Bangladesh Awami League, was elected Member of Parliament of Rangpur-4 constituency on 05 January, 2014 in the 10th parliamentary election for the second time. He was a member of Parliamentary Standing Committee on Ministry of Home Affairs and Ministry of Finance in the 10th parliament. He was elected secretary of planning and finance of Bangladesh Awami League central executive committee in 2017. He was elected Member of Parliament of Rangpur-4 constituency in 2014 in the 11th parliamentary election for the third time. Tipu Munshi took oath as Minister of Commerce in the cabinet of Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina on 07 January 2019.

As an establish business man Mr. Tipu Munshi served as chairman of BGMEA from 2005 to 2006. Presently he is serving as chairman of the joint forum of the Garment's Owners. He visited the USA, Australia, Malaysia and India with Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina as business representative.

He is involved in different social and cultural activities and has established many philanthropic organization.

He is father of two daughters. Listening song, reading book, and travelling are his favorite hobbies.

H.E. ZULKIFLI HASANTrade Minister, Republic of Indonesia

Zulkiffi Hasan, often called Bang Zul, was appointed as Minister of Trade of the Republic of Indonesia on June 15th, 2022 by the Honorable President Joko Widodo.

Prior to this appointment, he served as deputy speaker of the People's Consultative Assembly (MPR) from 2019 until 2022. Previously, he was also honored as the speaker of the MPR from 2014 to 2019.

Born in Lampung on 17 May 1962, Minister Zulkifli Hasan grew up in a family of farmers, which significantly inspired his entrepreneurial interest and career trajectory. Once a civil servant, young Zulkifli decided to switch his professions to become an entrepreneur. He eventually started his own business and managed to lead several companies in the retail sector.

After starting his political career, he did not abandon his entrepreneurial interests. Besides being active in the Muhammadiyah, his keen interest in young entrepreneurs was demonstrated during his tenure as the head of the Regional Board of Farmers and Fishermen of Lampung Province, deputy chairman of Lampung Sai Community Society, and initiated the Lampung Youth Union. He chaired Muhammadiyah's Institute of Agricultural Laborers and Fishermen from 2000 to 2005.

His political career in PAN has always been colored with citizen-centered

thinking. He once served as Secretary-General of PAN in 2005-2010 before taking up the leadership of the party. Zulkifli was also a member of the DPR for the 2005-2009 period in House Commission VI, overseeing industry, investment, and business competition. From 2009 to 2014, Zulkifli Hasan served as Minister of Forestry under the United Indonesia Cabinet II. During his time, he launched two important policies, which proved to be beneficial in preserving the

Indonesian forest area. Minister Hasan initiated the One Billion Tree Planting Movement, which involved all levels of society, including corporations, indigenous communities, the government, and our military forces. Zulkifli Hasan was also known as the mastermind of the Moratorium on the Issuance of Forest Utilization Permits, in which the moratorium policy was proclaimed to be able to save millions of hectares of land throughout Indonesia.

As the son of a rural farmer, he is widely regarded as a "self-made man". Given his record in building businesses completely from the ground up, Minister Hasan developed a very strong sensitivity and empathy towards marginalized communities. Empowering inclusivity and people-centered governance has always been his core principles as a politician, making him known by many merchants in traditional markets as "a true pro-merchants politician". He was appointed by the President as Minister of Trade not only based on his undeniable strong track records as an entrepreneur, but also on his familiarity with field operations.

In terms of education, Zulkifli Hasan studied Economics at Krisnadwipayana University in 1996. He then graduated from PPM School of Management with Master of Management in 2003. He has received two prestigious honorary doctorates (Honoris Causa) in the field of Public Administration from Korean Sejong University and Human Resource Management (HR) from the State University of Semarang.

Minister Zulkifli is married and blessed with four children: two daughters and two sons.



He was part of the core group of advisors and strategists during India's economic reforms of 1991 where he was principal interlocutor for negotiations with the World Bank and the International Monetary Fund (IMF).

Mr. Singh brings a wealth of national and international experience to the table, having interacted closely with multilateral organizations such as the World Bank, IMF, ADB, and OECD. His early work as First Minister, Economic and

The Japanese order is the second-highest civilian award accorded to people with distinguished achievements in the field of international relations, promotion of Japanese culture, development in welfare or preservation of the environment. He was the only Indian in the list of recipients of 2016 Spring Imperial Decorations.

He was a Member of the Mentor Group, and later, the Governing Board of the Nalanda University and Chairperson of its Endowments Committee. He is currently the Co-Chair of the India Advisory Board of the London School of Economics (LSE) along with Lord Nicholas Stern.

Mr Singh is also a published author with several prominent books to his name. "Politics of Change", an insight into India's politics and economy, provides incisive insights into the realities of coalition politics and international fault lines. "Not by Reason Alone," comments on the past and present of the politics of change and "The New Bihar: Rekindling Governance and Development", is a collection of perceptive essays on the Bihar model of development. His autobiography "Portraits of Power: Half a Century of Being at Ringside" was published in 2020. His latest book "Recalibrate: Changing Paradigms" is a compilation of essays written in the context of the COVID-19 pandemic on a wide range of subjects including fiscal policy, federalism, health, education, geopolitics and climate change to mention a few. He has been a reputed columnist in leading Indian newspapers including the likes of Hindustan Times, Hindustan, The Indian Express, The Hindu, and Mint.

Natarajan Chandrasekaran (Chandra) is the Chairman of Tata Sons, the holding company and promoter of all Tata Group companies, and the Chair of B20 India.



1890. Since then, the Group has enveloped from a trading business to become one of the biggest industrial concerns of Mauritius. Present in Mobile Telephony and Media as majority owners of the second largest mobile operator in Mauritius and the largest Pay TV operator, Hotels, Food & Beverages production and distribution, Home & Personal Care production and distribution, the Currimjee Group has a consolidated turnover of some USD 200 Million and employs some 2000 staff.

He was the President of the Mauritius Chamber of Commerce and Industry (MCCI) from March 2016 to March 2018, a responsibility he also held in 2007. The MCCI is one of the leading private sector institution of Mauritius and the principal Chamber of Commerce and Industry in Mauritius, established in 1850. As President of the MCCI, he actively received delegations from India led by CII and FICI and is now the Chair of the India Joint Business Council of Mauritius.

In addition, Mr. Currimjee, as President of the MCCI, successfully postulated for the post of the First Vice President of the COMESA Business Council. 

Founded in 1817, the New York Academy is among the oldest scientific organizations in the United States. The mission of the Academy is to drive innovative solutions to society's challenges by advancing scientific research, education, and policy.

In 2012, Dirks was named as the 10th Chancellor of the University of California, Berkeley and served in that role until July of 2017. He launched major initiatives in undergraduate education and research collaborations in areas such as neuroscience and genomics. He oversaw the establishment of a new division of Data Science, and led a series of bold global projects including the creation of the Tsinghua Berkeley Shenzhen Institute and a global alliance with Cambridge University, the National University of Singapore, and several other institutions.


Dirks took on unprecedented challenges to improve the financial and institutional health of the university—diminished as it was by draconian cuts in state funding, problems with academic achievement for student athletes, inadequate procedures to combat sexual harassment and violence on campus, and recurrent controversies related to free speech and inflammatory speakers. He also focused on increasing accessibility for low-income and

underrepresented students.

Before joining Berkeley, Dirks was the executive vice president for the arts and sciences and dean of the faculty at Columbia University, where he worked to improve and diversify the faculty, putting special emphasis on interdisciplinary and international initiatives. The Franz Boas Professor of Anthropology and History, Dirks joined Columbia in 1997 as chair of the anthropology department. Prior to his appointment at Columbia, for ten years he was a professor of history and anthropology at the University of Michigan. Before that, he taught Asian history and civilization at the California Institute of Technology.

Dirks received his B.A. from Wesleyan University, and his M.A. and Ph.D. from the University of Chicago. He has published four major books, edited three others, and written numerous essays and articles. He has held prestigious fellowships and scholarships and received several scholarly honors, including a Guggenheim Fellowship, a MacArthur Foundation residential fellowship at the Institute for Advanced Study at Princeton, and the Lionel Trilling Award for his book, Castes of Mind. His newest book, City of Intellect: The Uses and Abuses of the University, will be published by Cambridge University Press in 2023.


